- Item 3.2 Credit standby arrangements: The Group has a standby facility, undrawn at the end of the quarter, with Trustees Australia Limited as trustee for the Interim Facility Trust in the amount of \$450,000 for interim funding purposes pending approval of a \$1,000,000 capital finance facility and working capital facility also with the CBA which is expected to be available for use in the June quarter. The Brucknell No 3 Farm and Ignatios Farm are intended to be included in the combined facilities provided by the CBA.
